What You Need to Know

As an instructor or facilitator, you can rest assured that these updates will be applied directly to the learning resources you currently have access to. There is no new version, and no new enrollment required. This means there will be no downtime and no disruption to your learners.

LMS customers will have access to all the updates through their LMS course with additional information to follow.

Any learner currently working through their materials can continue where they left off. They will see the new features within their existing learning resource experience, and all progress made within their modules will remain intact.

Note: New lesson quizzes will now appear within modules and on the learner dashboard. This may slightly impact how overall lesson progress is tracked. Learners whose modules previously appeared as complete may now see lesson quizzes marked as incomplete. Learners do not need to return to previously completed modules to submit the new quizzes unless your program requires it. Completion status **does not impact eligibility** to sit for any NHA exam; eligibility remains based on candidate program completion or work experience, not learning resource completion. Added to every lesson in every module across all learning resources listed above.

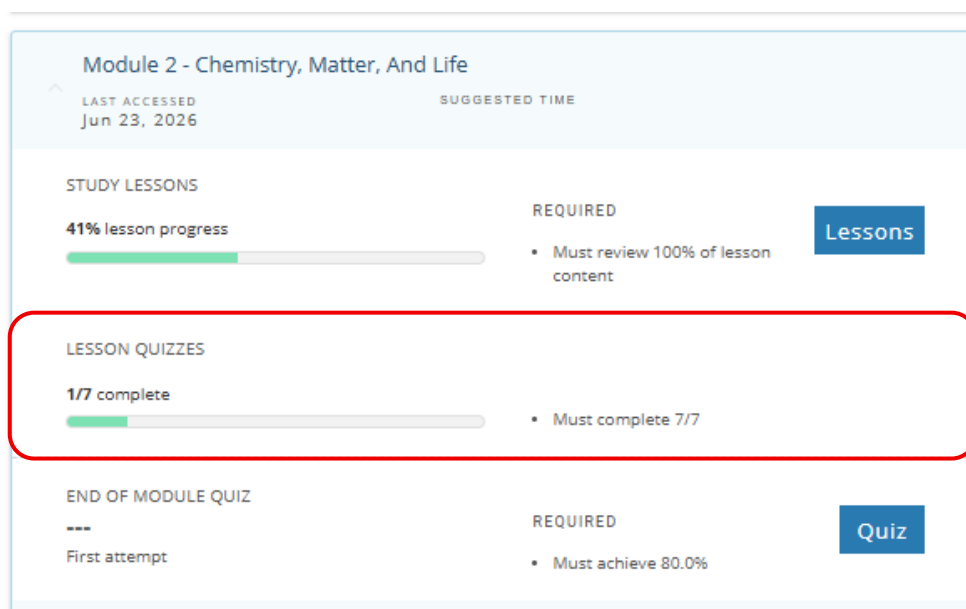
Upon launch, every lesson within each module now includes a lesson-level micro-quiz that learners can access directly from within the lesson, while their learning is still fresh. These micro-quizzes give facilitators a more granular view of each learner's progress and retention throughout the course, rather than relying solely on performance at the end of a module.

What Facilitators Will Notice:

- Lesson quiz scores are visible in the **Learning Insights Center**.
- Learners will see a new **Lesson Quiz Progress** section on their course dashboard, displayed next to the existing study lesson progress tracker.
- End-of-module quizzes **have not changed** — lesson quizzes are an addition, providing more checkpoints to identify knowledge gaps early in the learning experience.
- No administrative setup is required — quizzes are embedded in each lesson and launch with a single click.

MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical Plus & MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical Quiz Updates

ADDITIONAL CHANGE

In addition to lesson-level quizzes and classroom activities, these two learning resources have one important structural change related to how simulations and end-of-module quizzes work.

What's Changing:

Previously, 12 simulations served as pass/fail end-of-module quizzes for skills-based modules within MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical Plus and MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical. These simulations are now embedded within lessons as non-graded practice activities, reducing learner pressure of module completion tied to simulation performance.

At launch, each module now includes a **fully graded multiple-choice** end-of-module quiz, creating a more consistent experience across all NHA learning resources, with results viewable in the Learning Insights Center.

Learners will still receive a simulation outcome report that they can print or save as PDF to share their performance results. However, simulation completion will no longer be tied to a successful module completion.

What this Means for You:

- Simulations are still available for learners — the only change is their location. They have moved into lesson content as **non-graded practice activities**, so learners continue to benefit from hands-on experience.
- Learners will still receive a simulation report upon completion, showing areas of the evaluated skill that fell below the target response including minor, major, and critical errors identified. This report remains downloadable and shareable as a lesson grade, if desired.

- **All modules** in MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical Plus and MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical now have **multiple-choice end-of-module quizzes**, consistent across every module.
- **For MA SkillsBuilder: Clinical Plus:** All modules will also have the new **lesson-based quizzes**, with scores visible in the Learning Insights Center.
- End-of-module quiz results are fully visible in the **Learning Insights Center**, providing more actionable data than the previous pass/fail format.
- No learner data or progress will be lost during this transition; all completed Module Quiz scores will be documented; they will only transition from Pass/Fail (quizzes completed prior to launch) or scored outcome (completed post launch).
